

Part-Time Youth Minister

The purpose of this position is to provide learning opportunities in a practical working environment for those pursuing future part-time/full-time ministry service. The position will allow you to gain insights on youth ministry and to improve pastoral understanding in ministry.

Below is a brief outline to give some definition and clarify expectations of the position of the Youth Ministry Intern position at the St. Louis Chinese Gospel Church:

Starting Date: TBD

Stipend: \$750 to \$1200 per month

Position Title: Part-Time Youth Minister

Work Schedule: a min. of 12.5 hrs/week (hourly schedule is flexible) – 50 hrs/month (See attached).

However, the job will also pay for work that extends up to 20 hours a week.

Person(s) to Whom Accountable: The Lead Pastor, in conjunction with the CGC Board of Elders. Must attend weekly staff meetings with the pastors for guidance and fellowship.

Qualifications:

- The youth intern must demonstrate a vibrant spiritual life based on daily reliance on the ministry of the Holy Spirit and a commitment to the spiritual disciplines, especially prayer and God's Word, and be able to serve as a role model to the youth.
- The youth intern must demonstrate a calling to and passion for future part-time/full-time ministry service.
- The youth intern must have basic communication skills in one-on-one, small group, and large group settings. He/she should demonstrate potential for effective, relevant communication with students, parents, volunteers, and staff.
- The youth intern must be willing to follow the doctrines of St. Louis Chinese Gospel Church (www.stlccg.org – for statement of faith) and submit to the leadership of the church.
- The youth intern must display a teachable spirit, open mind, and servant attitude.

Responsibilities:

Youth Ministry

- Oversee the youth ministry (grades 7-12); provide spiritual leadership in the planning and implementation of all youth activities with the current Teen Counselors and student leaders;
- Teach at the Friday night Youth Group meetings;
- Relate to the teens in the church as both their friend and mentor;
- Encourage and motivate the Teen Counselors.

Terms of Service: After an initial review following the first six months of service, there will be an annual review every 12 months. A minimum of one year of service is desired. If you sense the need to resign, we ask for a minimum of a 30 day notice and to specifically discuss your reasons with the CGC Elders. Likewise, the Elders will give you a 30 day notice and reasons if a termination is needed.

Reasons for Termination: You may be terminated if you do not follow the assigned job description and duties; if you display a hostile attitude towards the church leadership; if you disagree with our doctrinal positions and beliefs; if you disagree with the overall direction with the mission and vision of CGC; or if involved in immorality or other behavior deemed detrimental to the witness of our Lord and our church.
